

## **Downloading Flash files from the Web:**

1. SWF files are usually embedded in an html page. Right-click on the perimeter outside the animation. Select View→Source
2. Find the movie on the html page. Ctrl F. Type .swf in the Find box.
3. Copy the name of the .swf file and paste it into the address box. The movie will replace the html filename in the URL.
4. Save the movie to your desktop: File→Send→Shortcut to desktop.

## **Taking Flash files from your Temporary Internet folder**

1. Go to the webpage that contains the Flash file you'd like to save.
2. Let the html page and animation load completely in the browser then go to Tools→Internet Options.
3. On the General tab, click the button labeled Settings under Temporary Internet files.
4. Click the button labeled View Files then do a find (Ctrl f) for .swf files. The List view is preferable.
5. Drag and drop any of the Flash files from the Temporary folder to your desktop.
