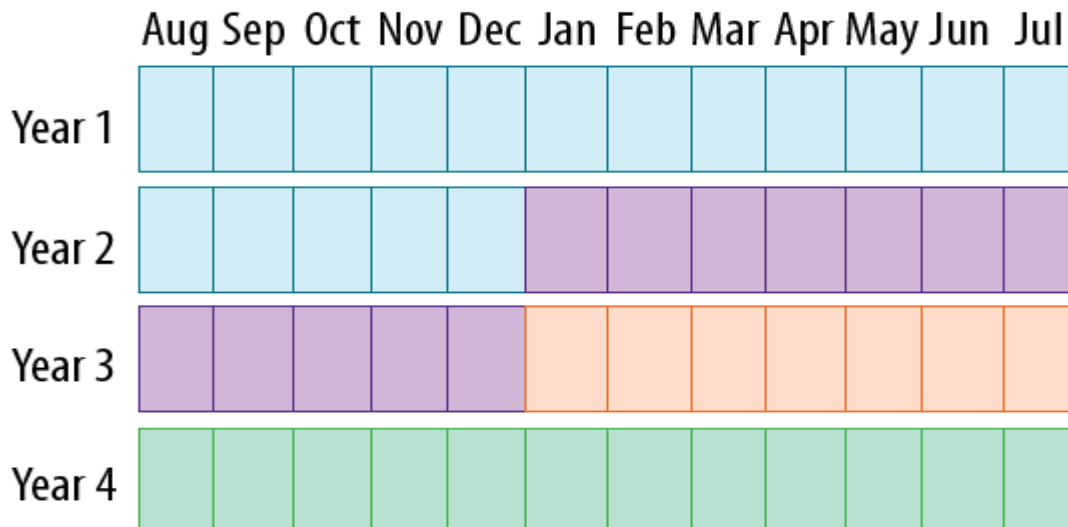



# NYU School of Medicine Three Year MD Pathway

**STAGE TWO**   
Core Clerkships, Interclerkship Intensives

**STAGE THREE**   
Step I Exam, CCSE Exam, Selectives, Electives, Concentration Project

**STAGE FOUR**   
Critical Care, Sub-Internship, Residency Interviews, Concentration Project, Step II Exams

# Customization of duration of training 3, 4 or 5 (dual-degree) pathways

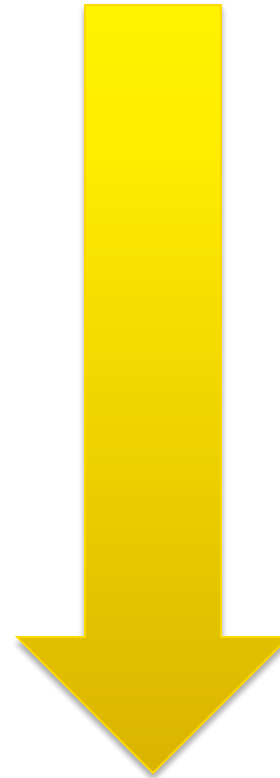
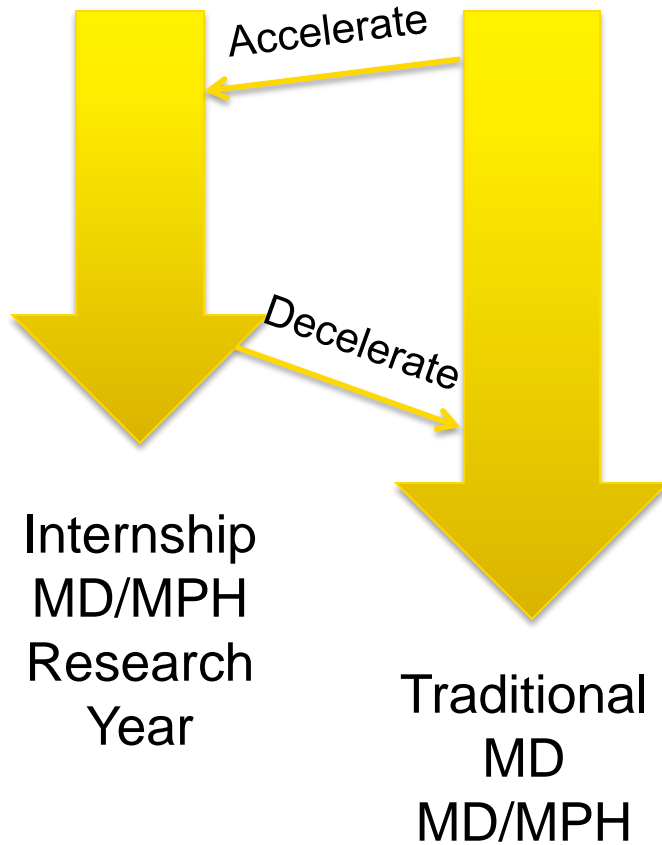

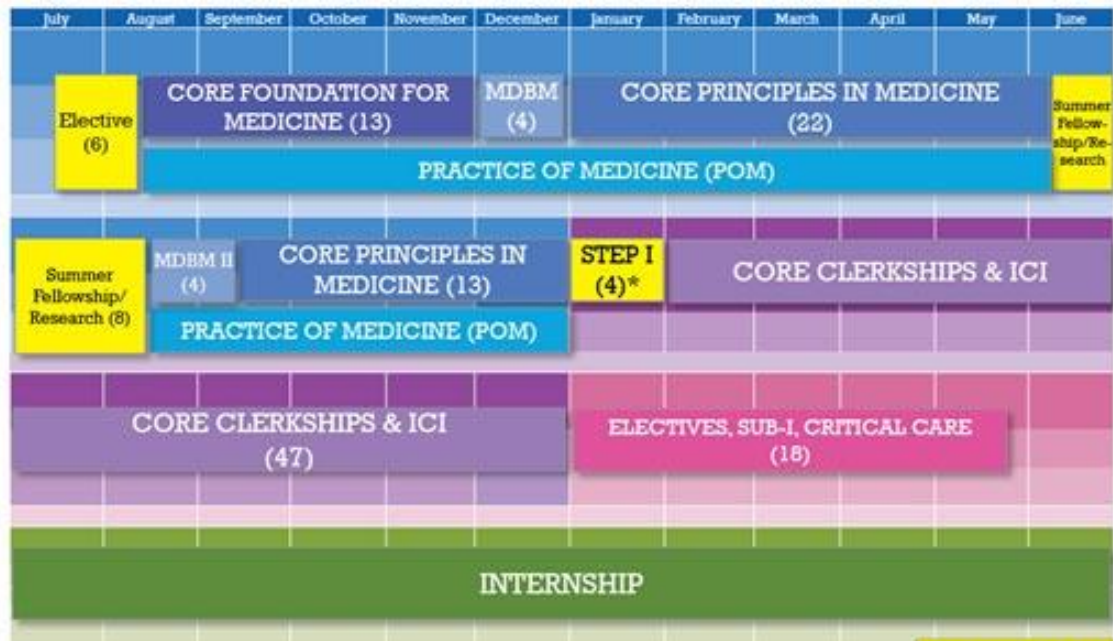

# NYU School of Medicine Three Year MD Pathway

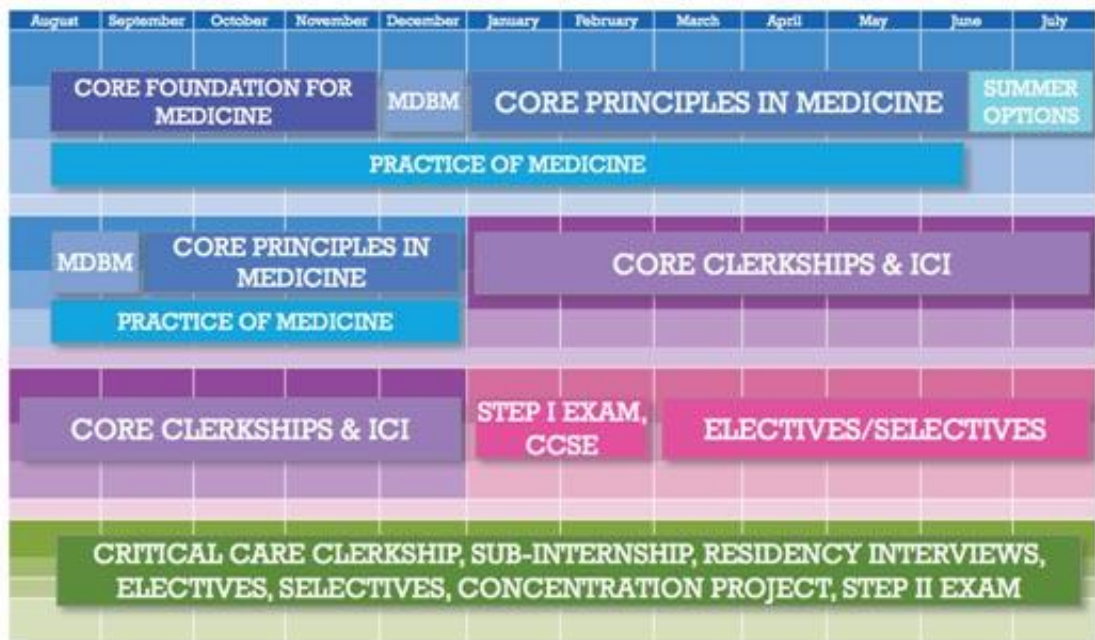
- Select group of students who are offered conditional acceptance into an NYU-Langone Medical Center Residency Program at the time of admission to medical school
- Participates in NRMP to be ranked by one of our programs
- Started September 2013
  - 16 students – 2013
  - 12 students – 2014
  - Opt-in pathway to begin in August

# Comparison of the three year pathway with the four year pathway

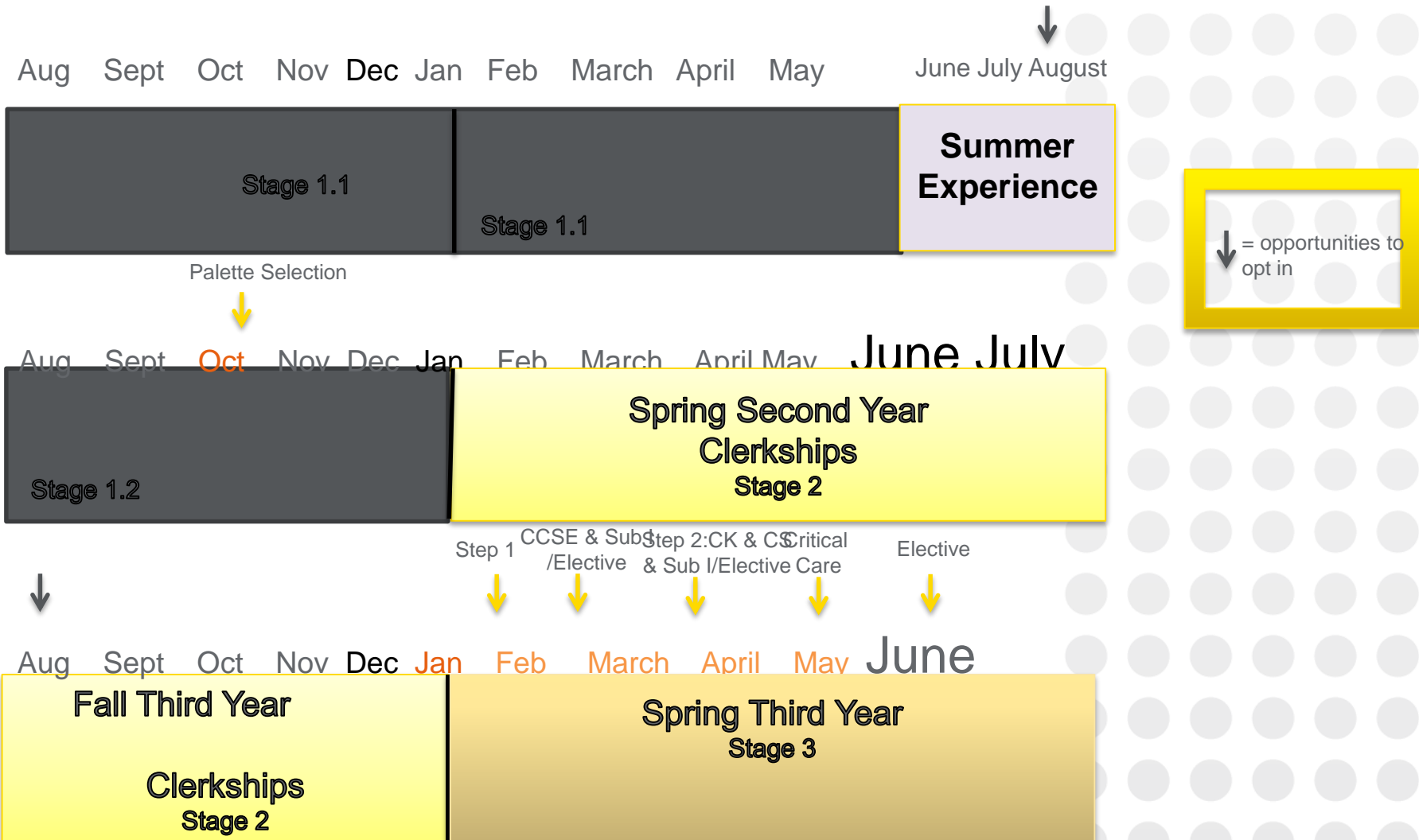

↓ = opportunities to opt in

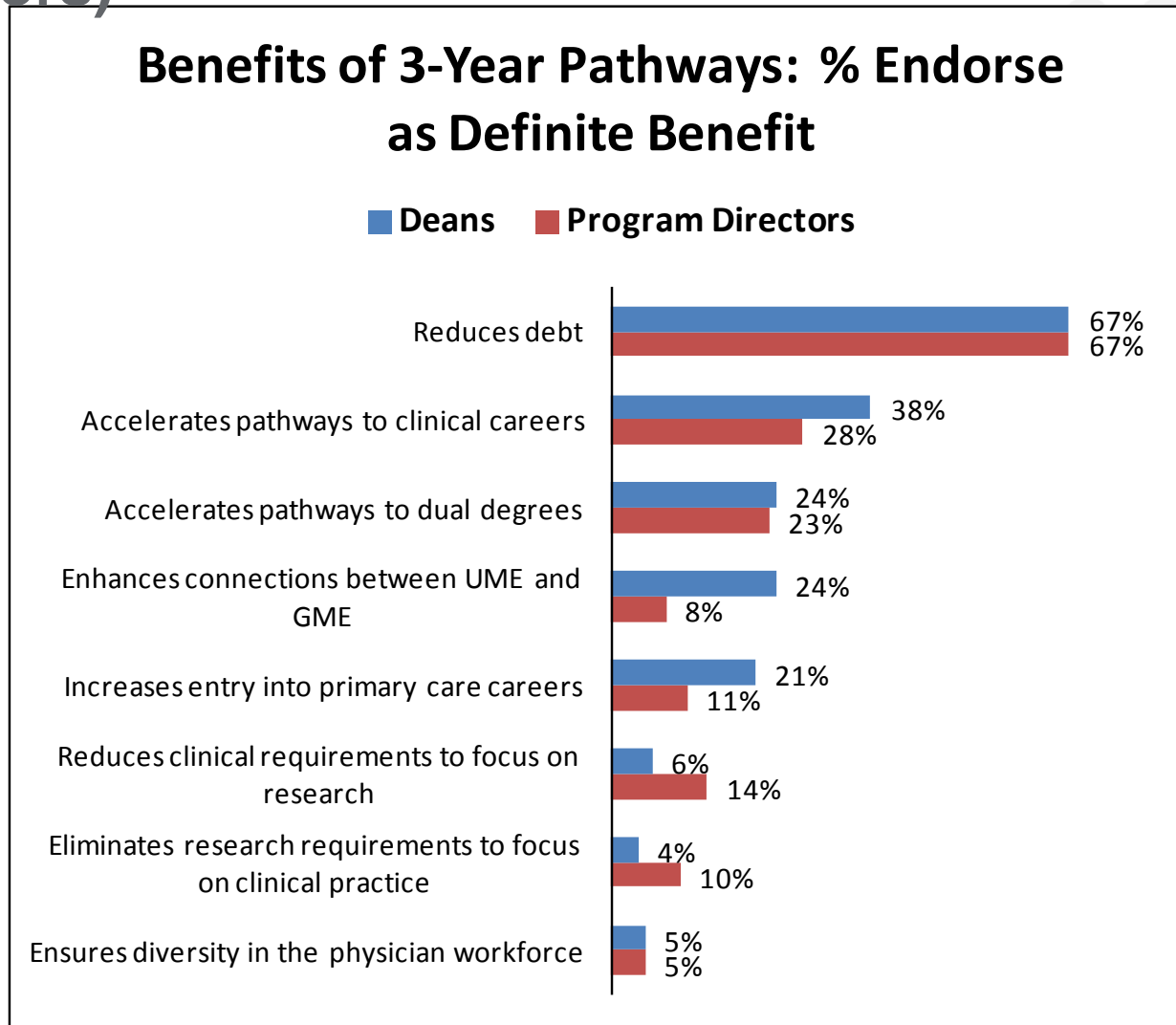
# NYU School of Medicine Three Year MD Pathway

- Continuum of training from undergraduate medical school through graduate residency training
- Creation of the UME-GME continuum
  - Tracking of students performance and development
  - Aligns with ACGME's Next Accreditation System
- Intensive mentorship begins in first year
- Integration into departments through education (shadowing, grands rounds)
- Research opportunities

# Benefits of the 3 year pathway programs

- Accelerated entry to desired field
- Particular value to those with advanced degrees and career interests
- For those in competitive fields, reduces need for extensive interviewing
- Reduced debt, earlier earnings
- Enhanced and earlier mentoring by departments
- Focus on education across the UME-GME continuum

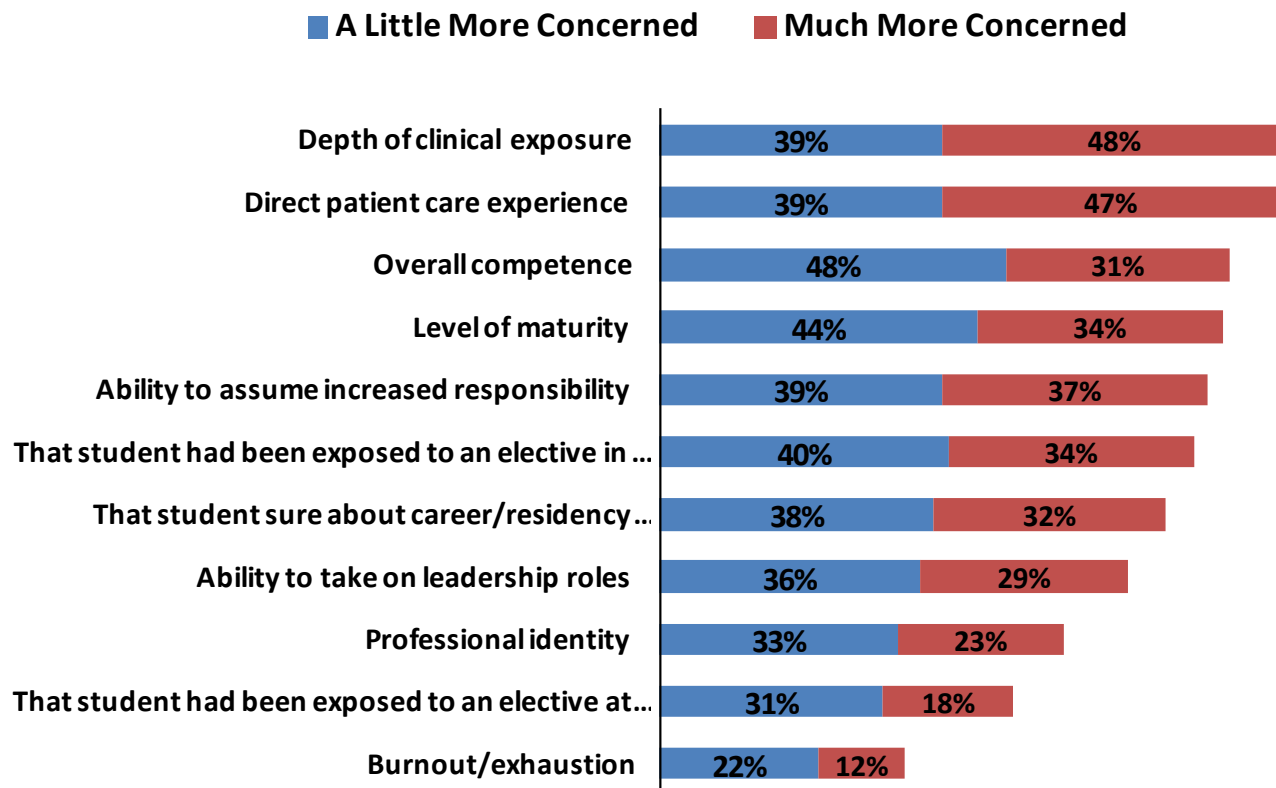
# Benefits of 3-Year Pathways (Deans and Program Directors)



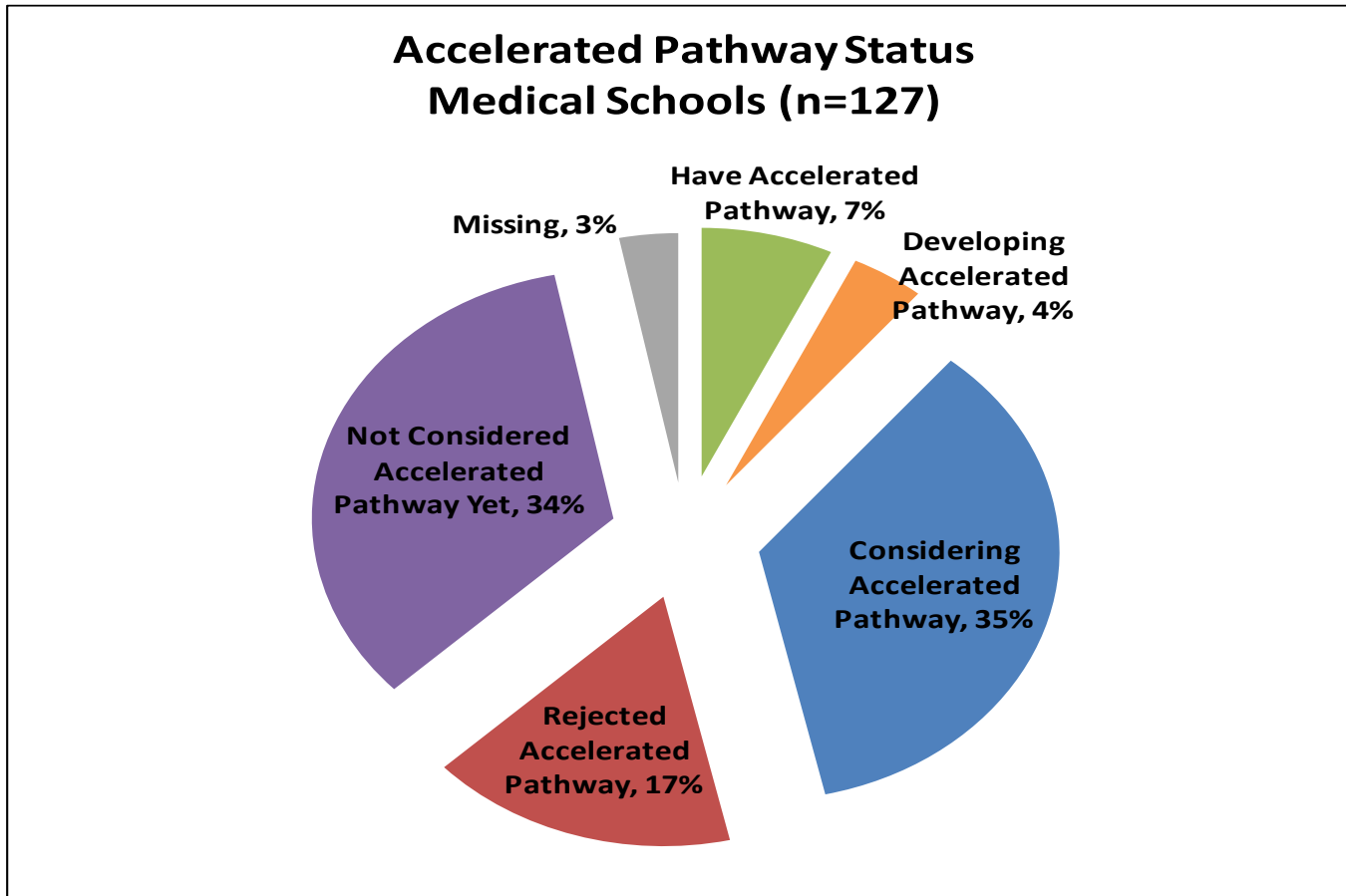


# Concerns about 3-Year Graduates Entering Residency (Program Directors)
