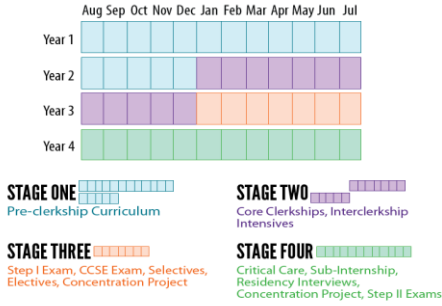
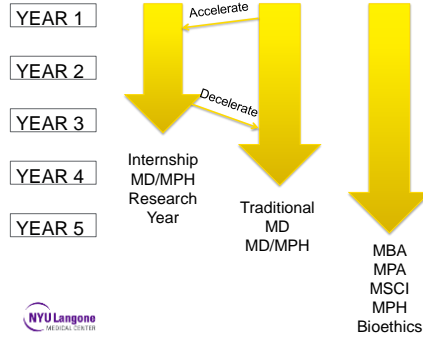


**NYU School of Medicine Three Year MD Pathway**

**Customization of duration of training 3, 4 or 5 (dual-degree) pathways**



**NYU School of Medicine Three Year MD Pathway**

- Select group of students who are offered conditional acceptance into an NYU-Langone Medical Center Residency Program at the time of admission to medical school
- Participates in NRMP to be ranked by one of our programs
- Started September 2013
  - 16 students – 2013
  - 12 students – 2014
- Opt-in pathway to begin in August

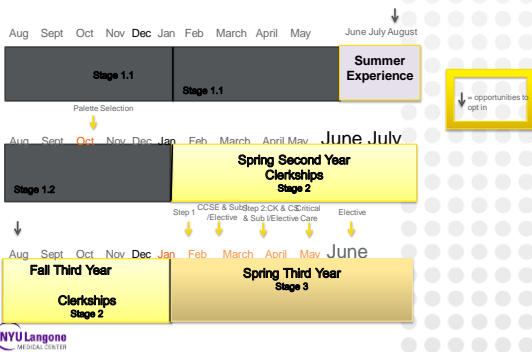


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**Comparison of the three year pathway with the four year pathway**

**NYU School of Medicine Three Year MD Pathway**

- Continuum of training from undergraduate medical school through graduate residency training
- Creation of the UME-GME continuum
  - Tracking of students performance and development
  - Aligns with ACGME's Next Accreditation System
- Intensive mentorship begins in first year
- Integration into departments through education (shadowing, grands rounds)
- Research opportunities

## Benefits of the 3 year pathway programs

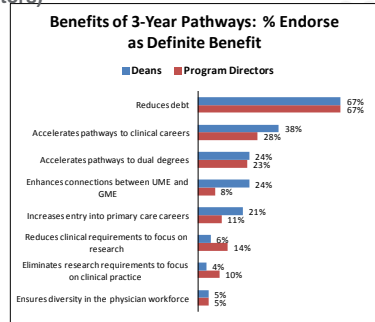
- Accelerated entry to desired field

- Focus on education across the UME-GME continuum



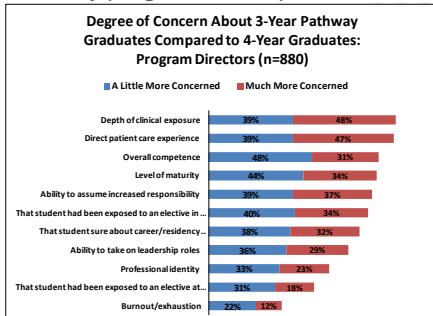
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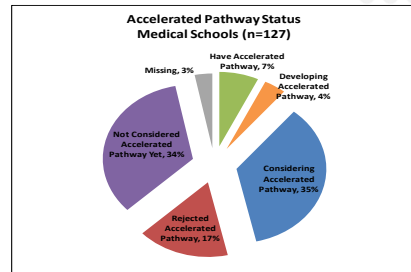
## Benefits of 3-Year Pathways (Deans and Program Directors)
